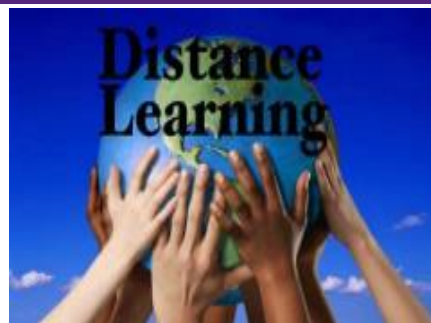


- During Lockdown we successfully transferred all of our courses online via Zoom

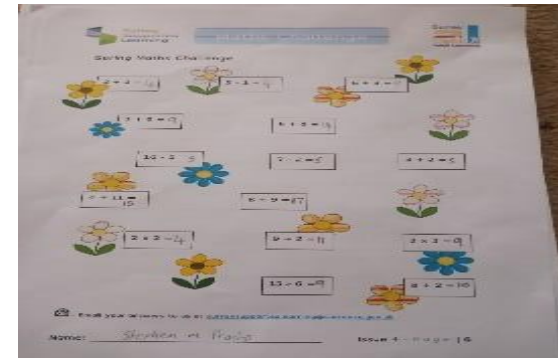

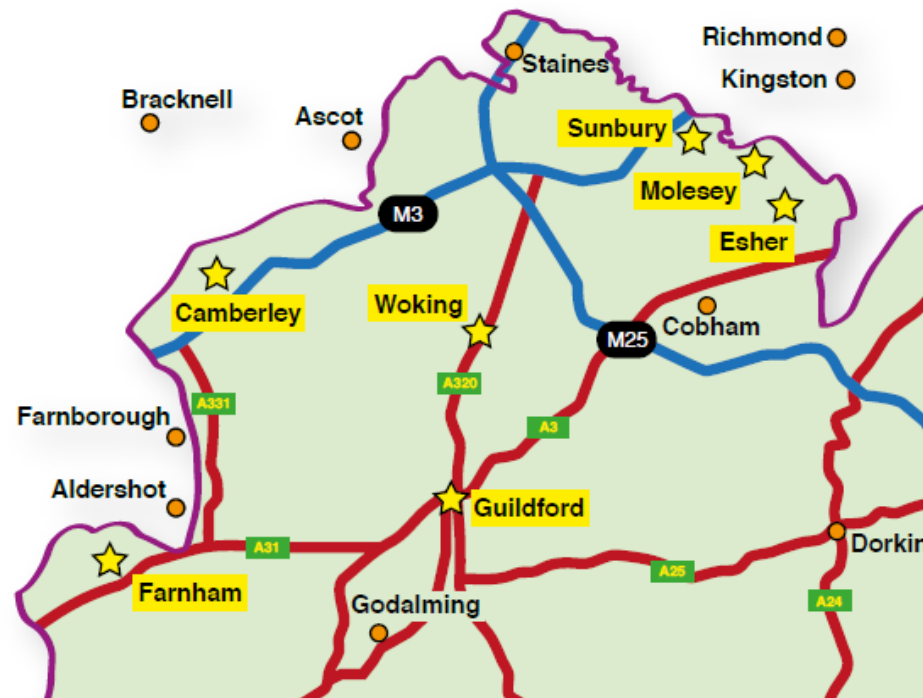
How to enrol
